Representative Matters

- Represented a manufacturer of medical devices in a breach of contract dispute as claimant in an arbitration proceeding, successfully defeating the respondent's motion for summary disposition. Following the ruling, the case settled in a separate mediation conducted while the arbitration case was pending.
- Represented a physician shareholder in a dispute against another shareholder in a medical practice over issues arising from the ownership and governance of the physicians' medical practice. The case settled in a separate mediation conducted during the pendency of the arbitration case.
- Represented a distributor of power equipment as a claimant in a contract dispute before an arbitrator, recovering damages and attorneys' fees for the client against the respondent who breached the contract.
- Represented a lender as a respondent in an arbitration proceeding where a claimant homeowner made allegations of lender liability arising from a loan to construct a pool, resulting in a finding of no liability by the lender.
